



## Ultimate Station middle and upper plates

**READ General Instructions FIRST!**


**TIP:** Most pieces fit together without glue.

Do a test run first, before gluing.

**Sheets:** The 2 large plates with the most and the least amount of slits in it. **No number.**

**Frames & little pieces:**  
**Dropper:** UDS1, UDS2  
**GW:** UGS1, UGS2  
**Storage:** USS1, USS2


**Other parts on these plates are for the low small units, see those instructions.**



**1** the pieces to be glued, including the 3 little ones. **do this for the upper and middle plates. Middle plate is the one shown in the pictures, with the most slits.**



**2** first place the cutting mat fitting into a frame and mark the corners. Cut these corners out of the cutting mat with strong scissors or a sharp blade.




**3** then glue the 3 little plates upright into the slots of a large plate. Glue the frame **VERY fittingly on all 3 outside edges onto the large plate and the little connector plates.**

Make sure to use the right plate with the right frame. The slits for the small connector pieces are in different positions for each version.

**Ensure that no glue is visible on the open slits or cutouts. Check both sides.**

Glue the cutting mat in place with e.g. super glue.

**Middle plate REQUIRES a cutting mat to work when assembling the box!**



**4** assemble the upper plate the same way. Make sure that the 2 little cutouts on the sides are once on the left and once on the right side, so the plates can be connected to each other. See setup guide.

**Don't let glue show anywhere! Plates may require a bit of wiggling / pushing to get it in place during assembly of the box.**

Tip: weigh down with around 20 KG of weights during glue drying time, so that there are no gaps between the layers!
