

Large GW drawers

READ General Instructions FIRST!

TIP: Most pieces fit together without glue. Do a test run first, before gluing.

**Sheets:
GDL1, GDL2**

1

1 Lower drawer: the pieces to be glued.

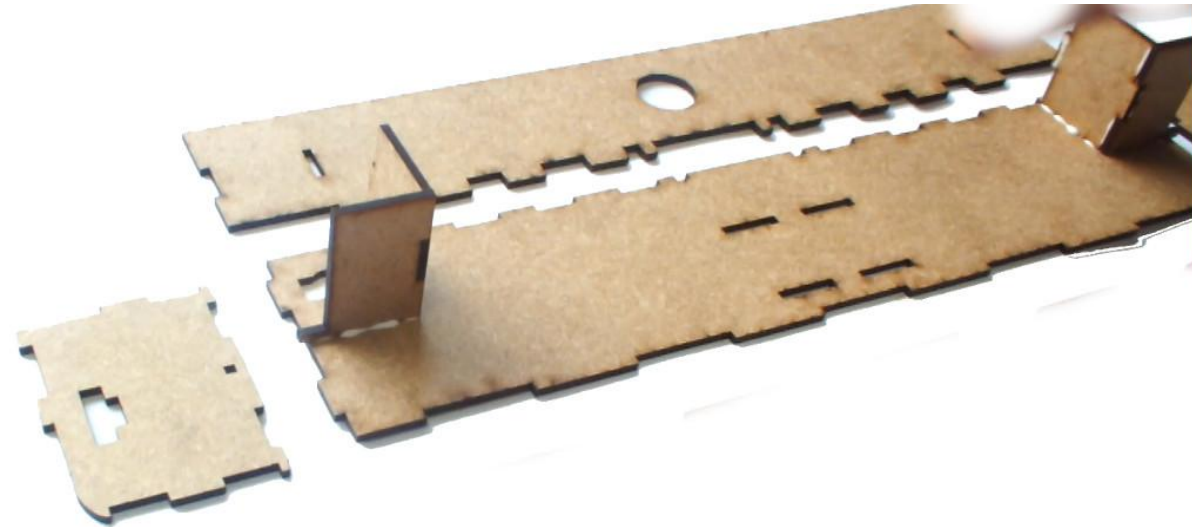
Upper and lower drawers. The lower drawer has the slightly longer pieces



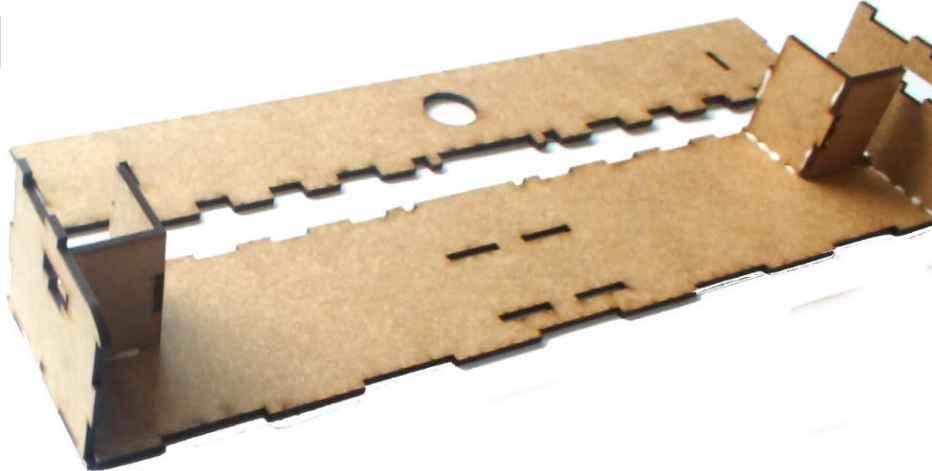


2 Lower drawer: glue the 2 little pieces into the slits by the keyholes as shown on both sides.

The small tab sticks out on the narrow side.

3-4 lower drawer:

Glue together from bottom, 2 sides, back and front walls.

Make sure the tabs from step 2 go into the holes of the back and side walls.

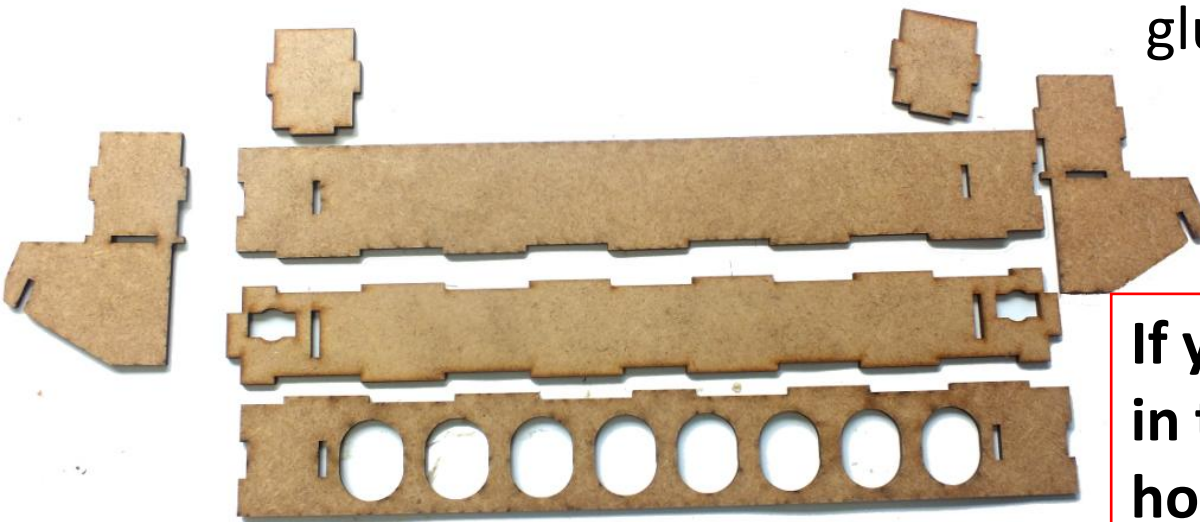

The “Bones” are to connect units to each other. No glue.

Large Upper Drawer:



5 Upper drawer:
the pieces to be
glued.

**If you want to store paints
in the drawers, cut out the
holes in the front first.**

**For tools, leave them
closed, so things can't fall
out.**

6 upper drawer: first glue the two small pieces into the slits of the back wall.

Then glue on the bottom plate to the front wall. Ensure right angles.

7 Then glue on the bottom plate to the back wall. Ensure right angles.

Glue on the side pieces. They only fit in one way. On each side, one tab sticks out. This is correct.



8

Tip: Insert upper drawer into the lower one during glue drying time so that everything fits together. They are fitting snugly.



8 Glue on the front wall.

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This is not a toy. Recommended for ages 14 & up
